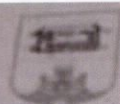



Savo Tomović rođen je 1983. u Podgorici. Prirodno-matematički fakultet Univerziteta Crne Gore, Odsjek za matematiku i računarske nauke, završio u julu 2006. godine sa prosječnom ocjenom 9,81. U toku studija bio je dobitnik više nagrada od kojih su najznačajnije: Plaketa Univerziteta Crne Gore za oblast tehničkih nauka za 2006. godinu i Studentska nagrada 19. decembar Skupštine opštine Podgorica za 2005. godinu.
